



Key Stage Two (Year 5 & 6) Activities in case of School Closure

When school is not open you can continue your learning at home!

You can:

- Make a musical instrument from recycled materials
- Write a short story about a mysterious object, use personification, similes and metaphors to improve your work
- Find out about a Jewish festival (You could compare it to a Christian festival)
- Make a fact file on a Tudor explorer
- Learn the map locations of countries in Europe
- Make/draw a comic strip about a new superhero character
- Write a fact file about an Artist of your choice (Try to include details about your favourite pieces of their work)
- List all the numbers up to 100 which have only two factors
- Read a chapter of your book and summarise what has happened
- Write a diary entry from the point of view of a poor person living in Victorian times.
- Work out 50 ways to make 50 using fractions, multiplication, division, addition and subtraction
- Design and create your own game to help younger children learn the multiplication tables
- Plan and cook dinner for your family (including the clearing up!)
