Are there any restrictions on hairstyles, make up or jewellery?

- All pupils are expected to have neat and tidy hairstyles that are appropriate to the School's ethos. The use of gel and hairspray is not permitted and natural hair colour should be maintained.
- Long hair is to be tied back. Hairbands, bobbles and scrunchies should be dark in colour.
- Make-up, including nail varnish, is not permitted in Junior School. No pupil is allowed to have tattoos, whether temporary or permanent. Pupils may wear watches but are not permitted to wear jewellery (including earrings).
- Parents should not arrange for children to have their ears pierced whilst they are in Junior School as there is insufficient healing time to enable the school rules to be kept.
- Spray deodorants should not be brought into Junior School.

What other equipment does my child need for school?

Year 3 to Year 6 pupils should have their own pencil cases, to include:
