Are there any restrictions on hairstyles, make up or jewellery?

- All pupils are expected to have neat and tidy hairstyles that are appropriate to the School's ethos. The use of gel and hairspray is not permitted and natural hair colour should be maintained. Boys' hair should be no longer than the bottom of the collar. Hair should not be closely cropped. No extreme hairstyles are allowed.
- No pupil is allowed to have tattoos, whether temporary or permanent.
- Pupils may wear watches but are not permitted to wear jewellery (including ear-rings).

What other equipment does my child need for school?

Year 3 to Year 6 pupils should have their own pencil cases, to include:

- HB pencils x 3
- Eraser & Pencil sharpener
- A set of coloured pencils
- A small 15 cm ruler or 30 cm ruler
- A3 zipped folder

Year 4, Year 5 and Year 6 pupils should also have:
