Homework is set on the day the lesson is taught, and should be completed (or at least started) the same night if at all possible.

On the occasions where more than 2 subjects are set midweek in years 7-9, the starred subject(s) could be carried over to the following night if necessary.

Science is taught as three separate subjects, one lesson each per week. Science homework may be set on any of the days indicated above, but not necessarily on all of them.

The total spent on homework each evening should range from at least 1 hour in Year 7 to at least 2 hours by Year 11.

If a specific task is not set on a day when homework is indicated above, pupils should spend an appropriate amount of time on further reading or revision in that subject.
